

TESPA KIDS CARE

Guidelines and Application Form

Description

Kids Care is a sub-committee of TESPAs that gives any student/students the opportunity to support another individual or organization by putting together their very own campaign! It also makes others aware of charitable causes and lets them get involved in helping make a difference in a number of ways. Just read below if you want to know how to run your very own Kids Care campaign!

Eligibility

- Any individual student, group of students or class of TSES.
- Campaigns must provide 5 interesting facts or points of information about the cause/organization.
- It is recommended (but not mandatory) that the campaign has a parent/guardian/staff available for support and guidance.
- The student/students are responsible for all campaign ideas and communications.
- The cause and campaign ideas must fall within HRSB's race, gender, and cross cultural policy.

Process and Deadline

- Individual students or classes will complete and submit an application by: **(Monday, October 24th at 9:00am)**
- The student/class chosen for the Kids Care Campaign will be notified on: **(Tuesday, Oct. 25th)**
- Members of the Kids Care subcommittee will arrange to meet with the chosen applicant/s to explain what they need to do for the campaign.
- From this point, the campaign must be communicated to the rest of the school population and ready to launch before the first day of the campaign week.
- The Fall Kids Care Campaign will run during the week of: **(Oct. 31st – Nov. 4th)**
- One fact or piece of information will be presented over morning announcements each morning during the week.
- The final day will consist of a theme day that all students can participate in to show their support for the cause.

Criteria

- All applications will be reviewed and must meet the eligibility requirements.
- Application forms are to be completed by TSES students only.
- All parts of the application must be complete.
- Campaigns will be judged on uniqueness, creative ideas, the information provided about the cause, and commitment.
